### **Biography**

Meiro Stamm is best known as a composer with the ability to fuse classical, contemporary and world elements into striking and memorable music. His film, television and stage credits run the gamut from children's programming and animation to action and mystery films to classical drama.

Notable projects are the animated series *Franny's Feet* (for which Meiro was nominated for a Gemini Award in 2005 together with co-composer Amin Bhatia), the Gemini Award winning series *The Toy Castle*, *Rick & Steve: The Happiest Gay Couple In All The World*, *My Big, Big Friend*, and the 2004 Theatre New Brunswick production of *Vinci* for celebrated actor/director R.H. Thomson. Stamm's score for the film *Bread & Kisses*, directed by Katherine Fitzgerald, was nominated for a Remi Award at the 2011 WorldFest in Houston, Texas.

Through his varied musical background, Meiro developed what he calls "the GeoHarmonic Concept". In his own words, "I have always been fascinated by similarities in art from different time periods and cultures. It's amazing to see how different artists, separated by thousands of miles and hundreds of years, often give expression to the same idea; a single concept bringing forth a multitude of outward forms. I want to create music that does the same thing in reverse - takes many forms of outward expression and points to the inspiration within."

Stamm served on the Board of Directors of the Guild of Canadian Film Composers from 2002 to 2009 and as its Vice-President from 2004 to 2009.

As a dual citizen of Canada and Switzerland, Meiro qualifies as EU talent for international productions.
